Wakefield Beasley & Associates to design Calif. center

Wakefield Beasley & Associates Architects Inc. of Atlanta will design a 950,000-square-foot hybrid shopping center in Oceanside, Calif.

The Pavilion at Oceanside will include a 400,000 square foot lifestyle center and 550,000 square feet of big box retail space. Wakefield Beasley & Associates is now doing the master planning, facility design and construction documents for the project. Newnan, Ga.- based Thomas Enterprises will develop the project.

"Historically, Oceanside has been a somewhat sleepy, laid-back ocean city," said Michel T. Lentz, principal at Wakefield Beasley & Associates. "However, there is currently a large, city-wide revitalization effort, and this project will be the largest shopping venue in the area."
